### MACROSCOPY:

Appendix: The specimen consists of an appendix measuring 70mm in length and 10mm in maximum diameter. There are no calculi in the lumen or specimen container. There no evidence of rupture. The appendigeal wall thickness ranges between 2mm and 4mm. The mucosa is unremarkable. There is a pale nodule present at the tip measuring 2mm in maximum dimension. 3 RS neck, body, and tip block A. (sc)

### MICROSCOPY:

The sections of appendectomy show **acute appendicitis and endometriosis**. There is acute inflammation involved the wall. There is no evidence of rupture. There is endometrial glands and stroma in the wall at the tip of the appendix. There is no evidence of dysplasia or malignancy. **(See figure 1 below)**
